Volunteers Drive - Seniors Thrive®

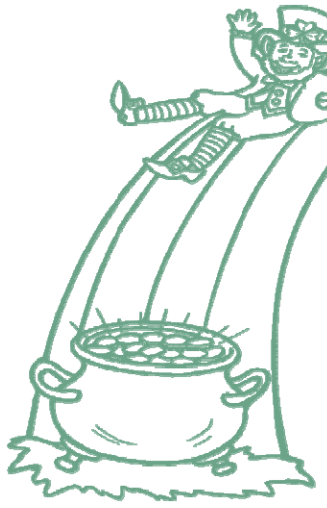
